

Terroir of the flag-bearing Climat MONT DE MILIEU

Right bank, the Climat MONT DE MILIEU

MONT DE MILIEU sits on the Southern flank of a hill sheltered by a wood from the North wind. With an averagely steep and regular South, SouthEast-facing slope, it enjoys the sun all day long and the grapes ripen easily here. This Climat is open and airy, and there is no rush to harvest its grapes which ripen very well.

With lovely homogenous kimmeridgian subsoil, this Climat presents a happy combination with multiple components: limestone clay and small limestone pebbles. The colluviums in the lower part ensure a good water supply that favors long maturation.



Domaine COURTAULT MICHELET is NorthWest of Chablis, in the village of Lignorelles. This 29ha family estate was created in 1984 by Jean-Claude COURTAULT, then taken over in 2019 by his daughter Stéphanie and her husband. They produce all 4 Chablis appellations as well as Bourgogne Epineuil Côte de Grisey. Stéphanie and Vincent MICHELET are the 2nd generation to run the domaine and are committed to producing authentic wines, focusing on the expression of the terroir.

Viticulture: South, South-East exposure. Sustainable viticulture. **Average age of vines:** 50 years old.

Vinification: In small temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks, alcoholic fermentation between 18 and 20°C. Ageing on fine lees, 10 months after malolactic fermentation.
